The Women's Missions and Ministries Department is committed to reaching unbelievers who need Christ; nurturing believers; developing effective leaders; and involving individuals and churches in sharing God's love to the world. We have sought to do this by:

**EQUIPPING LEADERS FOR MINISTRY AND WITNESS**

- Associational leadership training for 49 associations as requested
- Coordinated 15 associational field service projects in 9 associations.
- Provided personal consultations in churches and associations throughout our state.

**INVESTING IN OUR CHILDREN**

- Conducted 2 Mom & Me Getaway events involving 215 women and girls.
- Conducted 5 weeks of missions camping with 531 participants, 11 professions of faith and recommitments and 52 career mission callings, 19 rededications and 21 other decisions; 104 churches represented.
- Conducted 2 ComeTogether events for Acteens, involving 211 youth and leaders.
- Conducted 1 Youth on Mission Rally with 116 attending.
- Provided training for 169 Acteens Activators and Youth on Mission Point Team members to participate in missions trips this past summer.
- Conducted 1 Missions Jamboree event for girls involving 198 leaders and girls.
- Conducted 1 Xtreme Missions event for boys and girls involving 242 persons.

**PROVIDING SPIRITUAL ENRICHMENT**

- Hosted SonShine: A Missions Experience for Florida attracting 276 men and women.
- Coordinated the Ministers' Wives Luncheon held at the state convention with 181 attending.
- Conducted 3 Language Women's Retreats involving 383 Hispanic & Brazilian and 573 Haitian women for the purpose of spiritual enrichment, training and fellowship.

**SUPPORTING MISSIONS**

- Networked churches in all 49 associations in a daily concert of prayer for the country of Mozambique, Florida Baptist concerns, pastors and churches.
- Worked with the Public Relations Division in producing age-level study materials for the Season of Prayer/Maguire State Missions Offering.
- Mailed and distributed Week of Prayer materials for International and North American Missions which involved: 354,604 prayer guides; 8,540 posters; and 453,055 envelopes; to over 1,500 churches.
