## PASTOR SECTION

### **A FAITHFUL STEWARD (Bulletin inserts)**

Four stewardship bulletin inserts using quotes from 1 Timothy 6:17-19: *A Faithful Steward Offers Hope*; *A Faithful Steward Honors God*; *A Faithful Steward Cheerfully Gives*; and *A Faithful Steward Invests Heavenly*.

### **A FAITHFUL STEWARD (Poster)**

This full-color 22" x 17" poster promotes the stewardship emphasis, *A Faithful Steward*, quoting I Corinthians 4:2. It can also be used alone to promote tithing.

### **\* AUTHENTIC STEWARDSHIP, Austin (Book) - Limit one**

A testament of Christian devotion, an illuminating primer on the mystery and wonder of a life richly lived with God. Every spiritual seeker, Pastor and church member should read this book.

### **BUILDING FOR THE FUTURE BROCHURE**

Brief overview of the Stewardship Department's BTF program, including costs, process, source of materials, and testimonies of pastors who have participated in a *Building For The Future* capital campaign emphasis.

### **CATCH-UP SUNDAY (Packet)**

A stewardship emphasis designed to help churches catch up on budget shortfalls or to catch up on special needs. Packet includes: preparation plan; samples of letters, newsletter, and envelope; drama; sermon idea; and evaluation/report form.

### **\* CHRISTIAN FINANCIAL PLANNING (Booklet)**

There are five areas of management to be developed in financial planning: earning, spending, saving, giving, and planning for the future. This information communicates to church members to understand and commit to these areas.

### **\* CHURCH FINANCIAL GUIDEBOOK (Booklet) Revised 2012**

Resource for ministers, Church treasures, Financial Secretaries and Church Financial Committees. Lists Internal Revenue Service publications by number and title. Updated list and current websites.

### **CHURCH GIVING MATTERS, Stroup (Book) – Limit one**

There is a wide gap between how pastors are trained and what churches expect of them. Pastors are trained to preach, while congregations expect them to manage a complex, non-profit organization, measuring their success by the people in the pews and the dollars in the plate. This book helps manage the tension between balancing money and ministry.

Four stewardship sermons focusing on different aspects of stewardship, prepared by Dr. John Sullivan, Executive Director-Treasurer, Florida Baptist Convention.

A four week (whole life) stewardship sermon on tithe, spiritual gifts, time and goals. Includes four bulletin inserts.

Camera-ready drama. By Mrs. Mattie Moran, this drama presents a married couple discussing tithing to their church.

A six-week study to assess the current financial health of an individual or family, focusing on developing a spending plan, getting out of debt, and managing assets wisely.

**LIVING LIFE FOR THE HIGHEST PURPOSE, Simms (Book) - Limit one**

A Stewardship Development Association (SDA) book by Robert Simms. *Living Life for the Highest Purpose* is about living for the ultimate reason—knowing and serving God. It is about how life itself is a resource to be used in doing God's will and experiencing maximum fulfillment. This understanding of life's purpose is an exalted definition of biblical stewardship.

**\* MANAGING GOD'S MONEY, Alcorn (Book) - Limit one**

God cares a great deal more about our money than most of us imagine. The sheer enormity of Scripture's teaching on this subject screams for our attention. In fact, Jesus says more about how we are to view and handle money and possessions than about any other topic—including both heaven and hell. Acknowledges the fact that money does talk, but addresses the question: "What does it say?" Dr. Hawkins includes eight chapters that help us face the reality that our canceled checks speak loudly about what is truly important in our lives.

**NAVIGATING CHURCH MINISTRY BUDGETING, Hackett (Booklet)**

Navigation is the process of reading and controlling the movement of a craft or vehicle from one place to another. As you browse through this workbook, you will be coached on how to navigate Church Ministry Budgeting for your church. This resource has seven actions and Ten principles of church ministry budgeting.

**\* NINE QUESTIONS YOU'RE ALREADY ASKING ABOUT ONLINE TITHING (Booklet)**

This book presents practical information to assist church staff and lay leaders about online giving as well as mobile and kiosk giving.

**OFFERTORY EMPHASES – 52 Stewardship Bytes, Simms (Pad)**

An offertory emphasis for worship services. Material is undated and available in written form as well as on CD-ROM.

**OFFERTORY WORSHIP PLAN (Pad)**

This plan is designed to assist Florida Baptist churches in leading their offertory worship time, with an emphasis on the biblically-based principles of stewardship and Cooperative Program ministries. It offers encouragement from testimonies and stories of what God is doing through our partnership in missions.

**OVERCOMING GREED AND THE GENEROSITY OF JESUS - STEWARDSHIP SERMONS, Broyles (Leaflet)**

Two sermons by Dr. Paul Broyles that complement the Sunday School lessons and are designed as a follow-up to the lessons. Offertory worship suggestions are also included for the Minister of Music.

**PARTNERS WITH GOD, Eklund and Austin (Book) - Limit one**

A biblically-based study on the subject of every Christian's responsibility and privilege to be a partner with God. The 1995 SBC doctrinal study.

**PASTOR, STAND UP FOR STEWARDSHIP HANDBOOK, Hackett, one of four authors (Book) - Limit one per church**

This book is full of practical ideas for pastors in the area of stewardship for use in the church. Chapters in the book include: *The Meaning of Stewardship; Stand Up as a Steward; Train God's People to be Stewards; Witness to the World Through Stewardship; and Disciple Stewards for the Future.*

**PRACTICAL IDEAS FOR YEAR-ROUND STEWARDSHIP PROMOTION, Hackett (Pamphlet)**

This pamphlet will provide a two-year plan of multiple suggestions for churches to promote year-round stewardship education. Also addressed are: the role of the pastor; a rationale for the biblical basis/theology of stewardship; and distinctives of a Christian steward. Besides ideas for Year I and Year II, *Twenty-Five Ways to Improve Giving in Your Church* is also included in this two-year plan.

Recommended for a four-Sunday stewardship emphasis, and especially for a *Building For The Future* campaign.

**REFRESH – FINDING JOY, FINDING STRENGTH (Annual education/giving emphasis)**

This three-Sunday annual emphasis on tithing is based on the book of Nehemiah. *Refresh* is designed to encourage members to refresh their faith, restore their families, and revolutionize their finances. When believers give priority to their faith in the Lord, it will lead to a restored biblical value of families and provide opportunity to give from their finances to the Lord and His work. A resource guide, three bulletin inserts, offering/commitment envelope, poster/emphasis guide, Sunday School lessons, dramas, a theme song, sermon ideas, and CD will be available for this emphasis.

**SERMONS, Green (Booklet)**

Three stewardship sermons by Dr. J. Thomas Green III: *Stewardship-A Matter of the Heart: The Pure Heart; The Deceitful Heart; and The Obedient Heart*. Designed for use in the pastor's annual emphasis on stewardship.

**SERMONS, Maynard (Booklet)**

Four stewardship sermons by Dr. Tim Maynard include: Redeeming the Time; FAMILYQUAKES; Gifted to Serve; and The Cost of Commitment.

**SERMONS, Mercer (Booklet)**

Three stewardship sermons by Dr. Dwayne Mercer include: *If God Owns It All Then... What Am I Doing With It?; How to Impress God; and Fear Factor*. Designed for a three-Sunday emphasis on tithing.

**SERMONS, STEWARDSHIP CHRISTIAN GIVING, Maynard (Booklet)**

A four-sermon stewardship series by Dr. Tim Maynard. Titles include: The Trust Factor; What's in Your Wallet?; It All Belongs to Him; and Gracious Giving.

**STEWARDSHIP CHRISTIAN GIVING (CD-ROM)**

CD-ROM contains: *Stewardship Christian Giving - Dr. Tim Maynard Sermon Series; Offertory Worship Plan; and Be An Encourager: Tithe* age-graded Sunday School lessons.

**STOREHOUSE TITHING, Montgomery (Leaflet)**

*Storehouse Tithing* is designed to present biblical and practical reasons for tithing to the Lord through the local church. Scripture is used to present God's plan for how He desires to have our gifts brought to Him. Practical suggestions are made for how the local church is to receive and direct the gifts.

**TAKING THE STEW OUT OF STEWARDSHIP, Powell (Book) -Limit one**

This book provides helps for creative preaching on stewardship and includes 10 sermons plus additional stewardship sermon outlines, quotations and illustrations.

**THE ISSUE IS COMMITMENT**, Goodson (Leaflet)

By Dr. James L. Goodson. Suggested usages would be as a Sunday School lesson, as a basis for a message on stewardship, and/or as a devotional on stewardship.

Offers specific guidelines on the offertory time. Samples of six offertory prayers are included for illustration purposes.

**THE MONEY ANSWER BOOK**, Ramsey (Book) - Limit one

Personal finance is 80 percent behavior and only 20 percent head knowledge. This book provides quick answers to your everyday financial questions.

**THE TREASURE PRINCIPLE**, Alcorn (Book) - Limit one

This book by Randy Alcorn is about the joy of giving based on Matthew 6:19-21—the Treasure Principle: “You can't take it with you but you can send it on ahead.”

**TRUSTED STEWARD - MOVING TOWARD TOTAL STEWARDSHIP**, Partain (Book) - Limit one

A book about stewardship that is not just about money and giving, but also about every aspect of a person's lifestyle.

**UNTIL THEN**, Laird (Book) - Limit one

An examination of Paul's teachings about every aspect of Christian stewardship, including one's life, talents, time, and resources.

**UNLIMITED : GOD'S GRACE AND GLORY** (Annual Education/Giving Emphasis)

A three-Sunday tither's enlistment emphasis includes: clipart; sermons; responsive reading; program guide; two orders of worship; drama; letters; commitment card; and offering envelopes. Also available is a packet of camera-ready stewardship Sunday School lessons for adults and youth, and teaching material for leaders of children and preschoolers.

**VITAL SIGNS OF A HEALTHY STEWARDSHIP CHURCH**, Hackett (Booklet)

Designed for pastors, church staff, and lay stewardship leaders as a guide to train, evaluate, and implement stewardship vision, strategies, and ministries. This resource is useful in providing the “vital signs” for measuring a strong and healthy stewardship church.

**WHOSE MONEY IS IT ANYWAY?** MacArthur (Book) - Limit one

John MacArthur explains the biblical guidelines about money and how our attitude should be toward it, He also defines biblical stewardship. Also included is an appendix on gambling, detailing why it is wrong and not biblical.

Bible study/sermon booklet prepared by Dr. James L. Goodson. The purpose of this Bible study is to help Christians commit themselves to a Christian level of giving. The study addresses giving as reflected in selected biblical passages.

**YOUR MONEY COUNTS,** Dayton (Book)

A biblical guide to earning, spending, saving, investing, giving, and getting out of debt. This book not only provides a practical approach, but one that helps the reader discover the profound impact that handling money has on a Christian's relationship with God.

### **A BELIEVER = A STEWARD: WHAT KIND OF A STEWARD ARE YOU? CD-ROM**

This resource, a data CD, provides stewardship presentations for a pastor or study leader and contains: eight weeks of studies; small group discussion questions; and PowerPoint presentations. This data CD consists of two sections of studies made up of four presentations per section. Each study has questions for discussion and can be used in small group or Bible study settings.

### **A BELIEVER = A STEWARD: WHAT KIND OF A STEWARD ARE YOU? (Poster)**

22" x 17" full-color poster promotes the stewardship CD by the same title, and quotes Deuteronomy 16:17. The poster can be used with the CD series, or it can be used alone to promote tithing.

### **AND SO WE GIVE...CREATIVE WORSHIP SUGGESTIONS (Booklet) - limit one**

Dramas, skits, and creative worship suggestions appropriate for Sunday morning worship or other special stewardship emphases.
